During the past year of the Covid pandemic, refugees continued to arrive and the Good Neighbors have continued to prepare apartments for newly arriving families. We followed the CDC guidelines, maintaining strict protocols and relied almost exclusively on younger volunteers for the actual set-up. During lockdown, we created a new web-site telling about our work.

Do you have questions about immigrants, asylum seekers, and refugees? Who are they, and why have they come? What help do they need to be successful? Our new website clarifies this along with stories of new arrivals. Take a look at how our mission is organized and implemented, with your donations of **Gifts in Kind (GIK)**.
